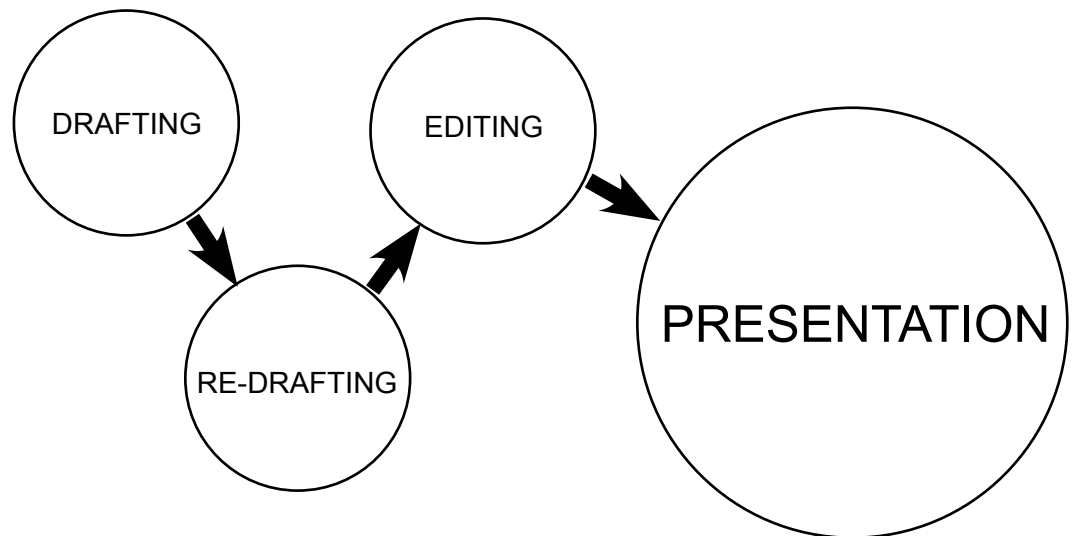


# WRITE A BOOK PROJECT AUTHOR CONTRACT

# BOOK IDEAS FOR WRITE A BOOK

You can choose one idea ... or two ideas....  
or chose lots of them and make your book

- Make up a story – it can be funny, sad, scary, adventurous – or a little of each.
- Write someone's diary – it doesn't have to be yours – it could be someone famous, living or dead.
- Make a cartoon strip.  
Add speech bubbles to explain whats happening.
- Write some poems – think of something you feel strongly about – or just have fun with words.
- Are you good at telling people what to do....? You could write a book of recipes for cooking, or instructions for making things.
- Could you be a journalist? You could work with a group to make a newspaper.
- Are you good at persuading people? You could write some advertisements or write letters.
- Are you interested in any particular subject on school? You could present science experiment reports, write reviews on books you've read, explain things about your school using graphs, investigate some local history topic or the geography of your area.
